Attendance

From **Monday 21 September 2020**, our reporting pupil absence system will change. From this date, there will be a choice of two methods to report pupil absence:

1. Send an email to attendance@shireoakacademy.co.uk detailing the pupil's full name and form, or
2. Send a text to 07943 823785 detailing the pupil's full name and form.

Once notification is received, a member of the Pastoral team will make a follow up call to you. Please do not call the academy reception number to leave a message or contact the Head of Year direct, as this will not be accepted.

Attendance is one of our main priorities here at Shire Oak Academy, as statistics show that good attendance leads to good attainment. The minimum level of attendance we expect is 96% and we will regularly update parents throughout the academic year. Together, we will ensure that every child's welfare and life opportunities are promoted.

The Shire Oak Award

Last year all year 7 pupils were given the opportunity to undertake the Shire Oak Award with the aim of rewarding pupils who achieve certain criteria in attendance, behaviour, house points ASPIRE grades and their wider involvement in academy and community life. Unfortunately the award had to be cut short because of the Covid-19 outbreak but we are still going to award pupils for their efforts up until we went into lockdown. Pupils will find out in the next few weeks from their form tutors if they have managed to achieve a Gold, Silver or Bronze award and will be awarded their respective certificates and badges. (The praise trip unfortunately cannot go ahead this year for award winners because of the current situation and restriction schools have in place because of the virus.) The Shire Oak Award will take place again this year for all pupils in Year 7 and 8 and will commence on October 12th. There will be more information coming out shortly regarding this.
