



16-19 Tuition Fund 2021-2022 academic year

Overview

In 2021-2022 Shire Oak Academy has received £8453 as part of the 16-19 tuition fund. The 16-19 tuition fund is clearly identifiable within the Academy budget and the impact of interventions is monitored.

Strategies

We will use reports from our MI system to identify learners who are eligible for support, using the criteria set by the ESFA. We will review at a subject level those learners whose progress has been impacted by the effects of the pandemic. We will consider at a subject level how best to deliver small group or 1 to 1 additional support in line with student needs and available resources.

We will deliver the Tuition fund small group learning using a variety of options depending on availability of resources. We will use existing teaching staff to deliver additional support, additional tuition staff and online tuition resources.

Intended impact

1. All students eligible will achieve a grade 4 in English or maths.
2. All eligible students will upgrade their GCSE score in English and maths.
3. Close gaps for students who have been impacted by the pandemic or who are disadvantaged.
